The great news is your attorney has done an excellent job and your settlement is almost complete! As you enter into the final phase of your settlement, please be aware there may be more to consider before you decide to take the lump sum payment.

As an individual receiving means-tested government benefits, such as Medicaid and Supplemental Security Income (SSI), you will want to be careful that your settlement funds do not exceed the resource limit. To remain eligible for these government programs, please consider placing your settlement proceeds into a Special Needs Trust.

It is often used when an individual will be coming into funds either from a personal injury settlement, inheritance, excess monthly income, retro SSD payments, etc. A Special Needs Trust is an avenue to protect you from losing those benefits we know are so very important to your everyday living.
